- Half of lung cancer diagnoses happen to nonsmokers, either former or never smokers
- Due to low access to preventative screening, most cases are found in stages III or IV and less than 16% survive

A **Breath of Hope Lung Foundation** was founded in 2008 by a group of Minnesota lung cancer patients, their families and their oncology nurse. The group recognized that this highly stigmatized and deadly disease would only receive the attention and funding it deserves through ongoing advocacy and public education. Before incorporating, the founders hosted the *First Twin Cities Lung Run/Walk* to educate the public about lung cancer, support lung cancer patients and families and raise money to support vastly underfunded U.S. lung cancer research. Today, the *Twin Cities Lung Run/Walk* attracts more than 2000 walkers & runners and raises over \$200,000 to support the battle. Mark your calendar: **August 13, 2016** at Lake Harriet!

Circle of Light Donors

<p>Ambience Donors help us sustain and protect the infrastructure we have built. <i>Ambient Light: Natural daylight that is already present in a scene.</i></p>	\$500
<p>Reflection Donors help us create hope for all who have been hurt by lung cancer. <i>Reflected Light: Light seen after having bounced off a surface.</i></p>	\$1,000
<p>Key Donors help us focus on creating change that will save lives. <i>Key Light: The main light on the subject, providing contrast and illumination.</i></p>	\$2,500
<p>Spot Light Donors help us shine a light on the injustice and stigma that must be overcome to save lives. <i>Spot Light: A controlled, narrowly-focused beam of light.</i></p>	\$5,000
<p>White Light Donors help us bring positive change and energy to all who cope with lung cancer. <i>White light: The space in the universe where positive energies are stored.</i></p>	\$7,500
<p>Incandescent Donors help us produce true change and awareness. <i>Incandescent Light: Produces heat that glows.</i></p>	\$10,000
