
Understanding Your Cancer Can Lead to Better Treatment Options

Suggested questions to ask your team:

- 1. Has the cancer been tested for all biomarkers?
- 2. When is a tissue biomarker test necessary?
- When is a blood biomarker test (known as a liquid biopsy) necessary?
- 4. How can I get a copy of my biomarker testing report?
- 5. Who will explain my biomarker testing results to me?
- Is cancer biomarker testing the same as genetic testing for inherited cancer? Are my family/children at risk?
- 7. Will I ever have to have more biomarker tests?

Trusting your care team and treatment plan is important. Seeking a second opinion may increase your trust in your care plan.
